Members cast their votes for the "murderer" as well as best costume and other worthy thespians.




The winners were announced, the dastardly deed doer was outed and we all had time to relax.

A cold, rainy day in January did not stop a full house of Peachstate PCA members and guests from heading to the impressive GMP Performance facility in South Atlanta.




Very special Porsche cars were all around, some getting health checkups and services or ready for serious driving. After the GMP Team was introduced, each had an







