An area for Concours prep is located on the upper tier of the main parking lot where you will have use of hoses and buckets in preparation for Saturday's Concours. Signs will be posted to lead you to the prep area and the main Concours area. Please be mindful of water conservation in car preparation. The main Concours judging area will be in the same area and Concours competition volunteers will be on hand to stage your car. Judging for the Concours d'Elegance will begin promptly at 9:00 AM and will conclude at 11:00 AM Saturday in the Upper Tier Parking Areas. The Peachstate Region Concours generally follows Parade Judging guidelines and is divided into two Divisions (Touring and Street) with awards within each mandatory for the ballot to be valid. class.

Last-minute preparation, as defined in the PCA Parade Supplementary Regulations, will be allowed on the display site until judging begins. Once judging begins (on any car), only light dusting of the car will be permitted for the duration of the event. Violation of the "light dusting" or "site cleanliness" rules may result in disqualification from the Concours event.

For the Concours d'Elegance event to conclude in a timely manner, the Concours entrants should remain near their cars so the Judges don't have to hunt you down prior to your car being judged.

Please do not use towels from your room. The resort will bill your room for extra towels!

"Tour Division" Judging is based upon Preparation and Presentation. It will include Exterior, Interior, Storage and Engine. NOTE: Classes PP12 thru PP16 -Engines are NOT Judged.

"Street Division" Judging is based upon Preparation and Presentation. It will include Exterior and Interior only - Storage and Engines are NOT Judged. PLEASE NOTE: Classes PP12 thru PP16 in the Street Division have been eliminated. Those Classes will be combined with the Tour Division. Only the Exterior, Interior and Storage will be judged.

AWARDS

Awards will be presented in each division based on the number of entrants in each division

1 - 3 entrants: 1st Place award

4 - 5 entrants: 1st and 2nd Place awards 6 or more: 1st, 2nd and 3rd Place awards

"Tour Division" Concours results are counted toward the "Overall Champion" trophies.

PEOPLE'S CHOICE - Winner is determined by all participants in attendance (Ballots are included in the Check-in Packet). Voting for two Concours Entrants, by the Car Numbers displayed on each windshield is

All ballots must indicate two Choices or the Ballot will not be counted. Ballots must be deposited into the People's Choice ballot box by the end of the Concours d'Elegance Event.

JUDGE'S CHOICE - Winner is determined by input, discussion and the consensus of all the Concours Chief Judges present.

SATURDAY - DRIVING TOUR: GA AND NC MOUNTAINS

The Saturday tour will begin with a participant briefing in the parking lot above the resort at 12:45. We will depart at 1:00.

TECH INSPECTIONS

Rally Technical Inspections - Saturday

Takes place at "Rally Out" on Saturday afternoon at the Concours parking area, prior to receiving your instructions. We urge everyone to "self-police" their vehicles to ensure functional turn signals, running lights, and horn.

Autocross Technical Inspections - Sunday

Conducted at the Public Safety Training Center site prior to the start of the autocross. Please empty all loose items from your car including removing driver's side floor mat, and ensure your battery is secure. Check your tire pressure and your wheel lug nut torque to factory specs. Lug nuts will only be randomly checked by the Autocross team prior to your run. A helmet is required to run autocross. The club does have a few loaner helmets that will be available.

The Sunday tour will begin with a participant briefing in the parking lot above the resort at 9:00 AM. We will depart at 9:15 AM or as soon after that as we are fully organized.

The tour is approximately a 4.5 hour drive broken up with multiple rest stops and a lunch stop, so it will probably take about 6 hours total and arrive back at the resort about 4:00 PM. The route will first take you to Andrews, NC where you will have a rest stop then to Robbinsville, NC, where you will have a gas and rest stop. Following that you will drive the Haggerty Road of the Year – the Cherohala Skyway. This is much more scenic and enjoyable than the Tail of the Dragon, which is shorter, and has more traffic. Near the end of the Cherohala Skyway you will stop for lunch at the Iron Works Grill. After lunch you will return to the Brasstown Valley Resort via some more nice scenic low traffic roads.

"Autocross" results are counted toward the "Overall Champion" awards.

Awards: Trophies will be awarded to the top finisher in each class and the overall fastest male and female participant.

Showroom Stock Category -

As delivered, no modifications. Adjustments OK if nothing modified. Street tires with treadwear ratings equal to greater than 180. Wear and tear replacements must be OEM equivalents. Spare tire & tools remain in car. (The class category is only for the relatively recent cars shown). Note: Treadwear rating makes GT3 illegal in this class as factory delivered. (See PCR section A-2.5.4)

Directions to Autocross site: (Approx. 37 miles)

- 1. Turn right when you depart Brasstown Valley Resort onto US-76 toward Hiawassee.
- 2. Turn left at first traffic signal onto GA-17 / GA-515.
- 3. Crossing into North Carolina. GA-17 / GA-515 becomes NC-69.
- 4. Turn right onto Hwy US-64 E / US-64. Continue to follow US-64 East
- 5. Turn right onto Industrial Park Road.
- 6. The Drivers Training Course of the Southwestern Community College - Public Safety Training Center will be just ahead on the left.
